VACANCY AT VALKENDORFS KOLLEGIUM

One room is available from September 15 2026, for a student enrolled at
The Faculty of Law, University of Copenhagen.

Valkendorfs Kollegium is the oldest dormitory in Denmark. Today, 22 students live here in Sankt Peders Stræde, in the heart of Copenhagen. Our rooms are split out across four floors, each of which share a kitchen, bathroom and shower. We have our own front and backyard full of rose beds, fruit trees and a lawn with plenty of room for BBQs, studying and tanning in the sun. Common areas include a living room, a library, and a TV-room. We dine together twice a week, host parties full of old traditions and maintain the house together throughout the year.

All residents are expected to participate actively in the social life of the dorm and to contribute to our community. Each resident holds an “*embede*” (a dorm responsibility), through which we share the tasks necessary to keep both the house and our community in great condition. Our monthly rent is currently DKK 1,825, with an additional dorm tax at DKK 200 per month.

How to apply

You can apply for the room if you:

- Are enrolled at The Faculty of Law at The University of Copenhagen
- Have passed at least 90 ECTS at the time of application

Your application must include:

- Application form (find it at www.valkendorf.dk/optagelse)
- Documentation of registration at The University of Copenhagen and of minimum 90 ECTS passed
- Your latest tax statement
- Motivational letter (maximum one A4-page)

Tell us who you are, what your interests are, and what you expect from living at our dorm. **Why do you want to live at our dorm specifically?** After the deadline, we will invite the selected applicants for further interviews at the dorm with our efor and three current residents. Physical attendance is required for the interviews. The interviews will be held on **Tuesday, August 18, 2026 from 4 PM.**
